

# WORKS NOTIFICATION

# SERVICE RELOCATIONS UPDATE, DOMAIN 12 JULY - LATE AUGUST 2017

Major works on the Metro Tunnel Project are now underway in Domain to support construction of a new underground station.

John Holland has been appointed as the Managing Contractor for this package of works, which includes the relocation and protection of underground services, including drainage, water, sewer, gas, power and telecommunications.

#### What we are doing

# Communications relocation

- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services on St Kilda Road adjacent to 400 St Kilda Road
- Non-destructive digging (NDD), including saw-cutting asphalt and digging narrow trenches to carefully expose underground utilities and verify the location of each service
- Relocating existing communication conduits and installing new conduits within the footpath on St Kilda Road between Bowen Crescent and Bowen Lane.

# **Gas Service Relocation**

- Confirming and identifying the location of underground services on St Kilda Road adjacent to 420 St Kilda Road
- NDD, including saw-cutting asphalt and digging narrow trenches to carefully expose underground utilities and verify the location of each service
- Removing a tree from the footpath near the corner of St Kilda Road and Bowen Crescent
- Installing a new high pressure gas service down Bowen Crescent
- Installing a new section of gas service on Park Street over five nights.

#### Drainage relocation

 Relocating the existing drainage to allow for the installation of a new gas regulator pit in Park Street, South Melbourne.

#### Power relocation

 Boring works at the corner of Park Street and St Kilda Road to install new power conduits beneath St Kilda Road are now complete. Remaining works at this location will once more require the left turning lane from St Kilda Road into Park Street to be closed for these works.

#### What to be aware of

# Communications relocation

- Relocating the conduits will involve open-cut trenching and excavating a large trench within the footpath using NDD and manually lifting the conduits from their current alignment to the new alignment, backfilling and reinstating the area
- This work will involve a temporary closure
   of the footpath on St Kilda Road between
   Bowen Crescent and Bowen Lane, with a temporary
   pedestrian diversion around the
   works area in the parking lane
- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work site to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- A limited number of parking spaces on St Kilda Road between Bowen Lane and Bowen Crescent will need to be occupied for the duration of these works
- Pedestrian and vehicle access and egress into the buildings along St Kilda Road between Bowen Lane and Bowen Crescent will be maintained.
- Night works may also be required to safely carry out some of the communications relocation works.
   The local community will be given advance notice of night works.



### **Gas Service Relocation**

- There will be lane closures and parking lane impacts for the required service investigation works
- There will be a partial closure of the footpath on Park Street adjacent to the Park Street frontage of 380 St Kilda Road
- Relocating the gas service main on Park Street will involve open cut trenching, excavating the trench, installing the new gas service, backfilling and reinstating the area
- Park Street gas works will involve closing the left turn lane from Park Street into Wells Street
- · Please refer to signage in the area
- There will also be pedestrian diversions in place.

# **Power Service Relocation**

- Installing the pit will involve piling to construct
  a retention wall adjacent to the tram service;
  open-cut trenching the area, in which the pit will
  be constructed; backfilling and reinstating the area
- Temporary fencing will be installed around the work site to ensure the safety of the community and workers
- This work will require the closure of the westbound lanes in Park Street for the duration of works with no access from St Kilda Road into Park Street
- Driveway Access will be maintained with traffic controllers in place 24 hours a day around this work.

- 7am 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am 1pm, Saturdays

# Park Street Gas Service Main

- 10pm 6am, Wednesday 26 Friday 28 July
- 10pm 6am, Monday 31 July Tuesday 1 August

All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and ground conditions.

We will notify residents and businesses if there are any significant changes to the program.
