URMET INTERCOM OPERATION

- 1. When a visitor calls a resident on the intercom system, they dial the apartment number on the entry station code pad finishing with the 'bell' symbol, or alternatively, using the electronic directory, scroll for the name of the resident or apartment number using the arrow keys then press the key symbol.
- 2. The video monitor inside the called unit sounds an electronic tone and colour vision of the calling entry is displayed. The resident can answer by pressing the audio activation/deactivation button and two-way communication takes place between the video hands-free monitor and the hands-free external entry station.
- 3. If the caller is to be admitted, the resident presses the video monitor button with the key symbol, and the door/gate will be released. This will also release the security at the lift so the lift car can travel to the floor of the called apartment for a pre set time.
- 4. The resident then presses the audio activation/deactivation button to end the call. The video links will automatically time out.
