Major works on the Metro Tunnel are underway to support construction of the new Anzac Station which will bring trains to the Domain Precinct for the first time.

St Kilda Road night works

As you are aware, asphalt profiling and kerb works on St Kilda Road are taking place overnight, between 7pm and 6am, from Monday 12 to Friday 23 March. Bore hole drilling will also take place in two locations on Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 March between 7am and 6pm.

These works were briefly halted due to the recent discovery of asbestos in a pipe under the southbound lane of St Kilda Road. Work was stopped to ensure the asbestos could be safely removed by licensed experts while minimising delays to the delivery of the project.

These works are being scheduled to minimise disruption to the road and tram network, and need to be temporarily extended to 10pm each night, from Wednesday 14 to Wednesday 28 March.

These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, but will conclude by 10pm each night.
