# IMPORTANT UPDATE

## DOMAIN PRECINCT NIGHT WORKS

Further to our letter dated 15 June regarding the 'wheel squeal' on St Kilda Road, we would like to advise residents and businesses that we will be undertaking works to trial a crack sealant on St Kilda Road, between Toorak Road and Park Street, South Melbourne.

The crack sealant will be a type of plasticiser which is designed to promote flexibility in the track and may reduce the noise that is currently occurring on the track.

These works will include saw cutting a narrow groove on either side of a 50m curved section of the tram track, and installing the crack sealant.

Works to saw cut the section of the track will take place on **Wednesday 18 July from 1am to 5am** and are expected to generate intermittent periods of high level noise.

Works to install the sealant will take place the following evening, and are expected to generate low levels of noise. Please note that these works may require an additional night, weather permitting.

These works are scheduled to take place at night to avoid disruption to tram services.
