

Works notification

Signage installation and linemarking works St Kilda Road and Albert Road, Domain Precinct

Thursday 19 November 2020

Major construction is continuing in Domain at the site of the future Anzac Station as part of the Metro Tunnel Project.

What we are doing

- Installing traffic signage at the new Anzac Station site gate on St Kilda Road southbound to allow trucks to exit the site
- Replacing faded linemarking on St Kilda Road southbound, Albert Road North and Albert Road South.

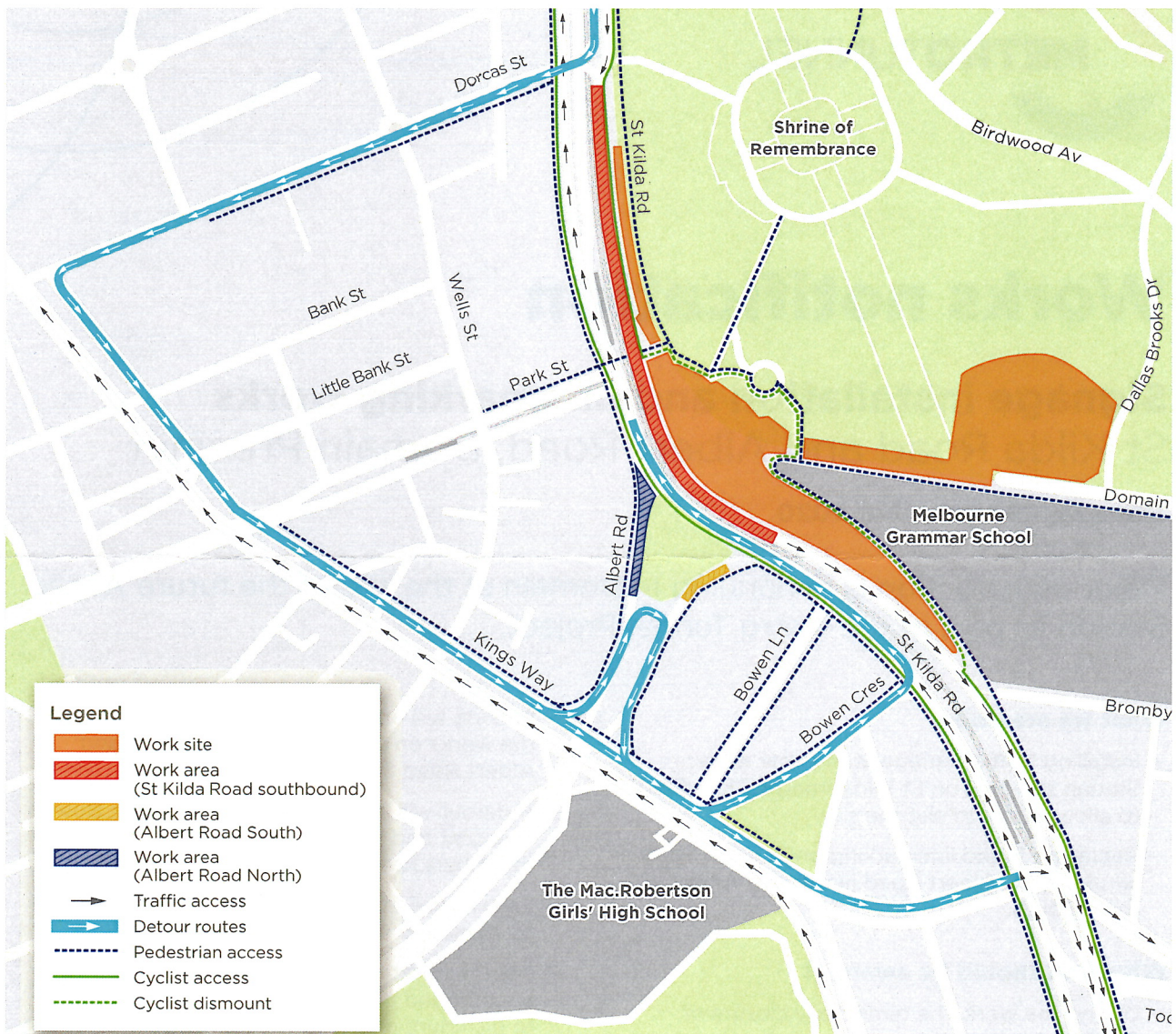
What you should be aware of

- During the work, the temporary closure of St Kilda Road southbound is required between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road. A detour will be in place via Dorcas Street and Kings Way (see map)
- Once the works on St Kilda Road are completed, and the road is reopened to traffic, Albert Road North and Albert Road South will then be temporarily closed at separate times adjacent to Albert Road Reserve

- Parking will be unavailable in this area during the works on both Albert Road North and Albert Road South
- A detour will be in place via Kings Way, Bowen Crescent and St Kilda Road for the duration of the Albert Road North closure (see map)
- Each of the three temporary road closures will be managed on site by traffic control
- For the duration of the St Kilda Road southbound closure, cyclists will be required to dismount and walk their bikes between Park Street and Bromby Street
- Pedestrian access will not be affected by these road closures
- Local driveway access will be maintained at all times during these works.

Metro Tunnel Project works are progressing safely under the current Third Step restrictions in metropolitan Melbourne.

You may notice an increase of workers on Victoria's Big Build projects as restrictions on construction sites start to ease. Large-scale public infrastructure projects are critical and strict COVIDsafe Plans are in place on all project sites across Victoria.

Workers on all of Victoria's Big Build sites are required to wear face masks unless they meet any of the criteria for exception – such as a medical condition for Occupational Health and Safety guidelines.
