PARKING SENSOR INSTALLATION

To make parking fairer for everyone, the City of Port Phillip has invested in 'Smart Parking' sensor technology and PayStay, the mobile app currently used by 320,000 Victorians. Used together, these tools will improve access to car parking, allowing more people to use the same space more often. They will also provide a greater understanding of parking trends so we can continue to improve things as our City grows.

The program first launched in our community in September 2018, and is now being rolled out to an additional approximate 400 parking spaces across the City. The streets include:

- · Bowen Crescent, Melbourne
- Bowen Lane, Melbourne
- Queens Lane, Melbourne
- · Queens Road, Melbourne
- · York Street, South Melbourne
- Cecil Street, South Melbourne
- Dorcas Street, South Melbourne
- Market Street. South Melbourne
- Ballantyne Street, Southbank

Line marking

The first stage of the works will involve line marking existing parking zones along the parking sensor installation area where required to separate the parking zones into separate bays. This will not reduce or change the amount of parking available in each area. These works will be completed within the next two weeks with only minor disruption experienced in the area.

Sensor Installation

The second stage of the works will involve the installation of in-ground parking sensors after business hours on the following date:

Monday 30th March, 2020

The installation of the sensors involves some drilling on the road creating a minor impact to some parking bays. We aim to keep this impact to a minimum with each parking bay becoming open to the public as soon as installation is complete. All reasonable efforts will be made to complete works ahead of schedule, subject to weather and parking bay availability. In addition, we aim to:

- · schedule works on days and times with less parking demand
- · contained all works within the existing parking bay areas
- keep noise to a minimum.
