Online Information Session – Draft Domain Precinct Development Plan Amendment

The Botanica

6.30pm, Thursday 16 September

The Metro Tunnel will create a new end-to-end rail line from Sunbury in the west to Cranbourne/Pakenham in the south-east, with high capacity trains and five new underground stations.

The Domain Precinct Development Plan was approved by the Minister for Planning in April 2018. Following this approval, detailed design on Anzac Station has continued.

CYP Design & Construction has prepared an amended draft Domain Precinct Development Plan, which includes plans for site layout, architecture, landscaping and public realm works required at Anzac Station.

This draft plan demonstrates how the works will be delivered in accordance with the approved Environmental Performance Requirements and the approved Urban Design Strategy for the project.

The amended draft Domain Precinct Development Plan will be available for public inspection and comment at engage.bigbuild.vic.gov.au from Wednesday 22 September until 5pm Wednesday 13 October 2021.

Prior to the start of the public display period, the project team will host a series of online information sessions for residential buildings immediately adjacent to the station precinct. You are invited to attend The Botanica session.

At this session, our project team will provide an overview of the key changes to the Domain Precinct design, the amended draft Development Plan approval process, and how to make a submission on the plan. The session will be held via the free online video conferencing program, Zoom.

If you are unable to attend, another session will be held during the public display period. It will be open to members of the wider community.
