

Works notification

Overnight works extension

Domain precinct

6pm to 7am, Monday 21 November to Saturday 26 November

Due to the ongoing inclement weather, surface works will continue overnight on weekdays to ensure critical works on the tram platform are complete in time for the start of tram realignment works.

What we are doing

- Road and track construction works, such as excavation, loadout, backfilling, rolling, asphalting and profiling as well as the laying of new tram track
- Ventilation shaft works including installation of cladding on the ventilation shafts
- Installation of tram poles
- Trenching drainage and conduit installations
- Cutting and installation of bluestone paving on the tram platform
- Fascia installation and flashing installation on and underneath the canopy roof
- Central platform fit out works including installation of platform furniture
- Kiosk fit out works including glazing, façade and louvre installation.

What to be aware of

- Works will continue from 10pm to 7am each weeknight
- The works are expected to generate a medium level of noise and some vibration when vibratory rollers are in use
- Noisier activities such as the use of non-destructive digging trucks, road saws, and jackhammering will not be permitted overnight during this time. The use of vibratory rollers will be limited as much as possible overnight.

26 November.
