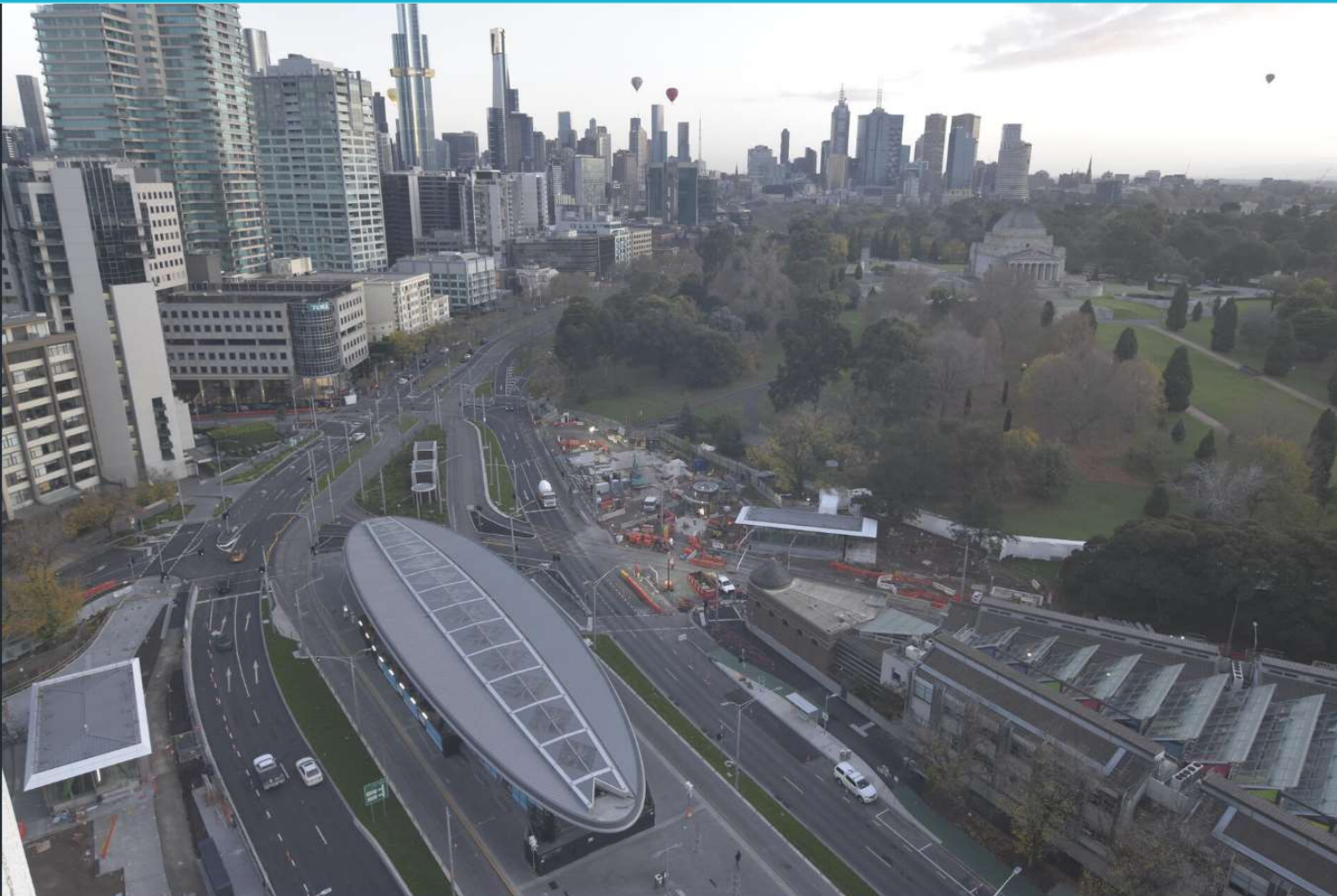




# WORKS UPDATE: STATION CONSTRUCTION

## WORKS UPDATE

### ST KILDA ROAD REINSTATEMENT



- Final northbound asphaltting was completed on Friday 31 May
- On street parking adjacent to The Botanica will be reinstated following the completion of footpath works
- Works to complete the left turn from St Kilda Road southbound into Domain Road expected in June

## STATION WORKS



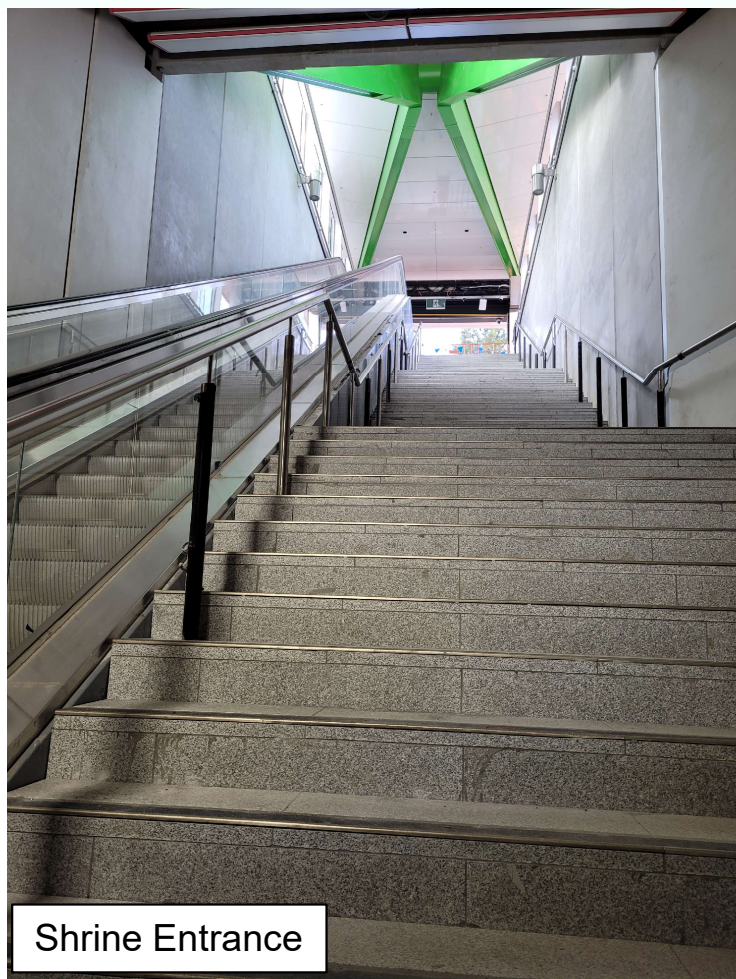
Station concourse works



- Works on concourse level are nearing completion
- Testing of systems, including fire matrix testing is now underway
- Paving works are underway on the stairs

## WORKS UPDATE

### SHRINE OF REMEMBRANCE ENTRANCE



Shrine Entrance



- Electrical and plumbing connections into the station are complete
- Retaining wall construction around the forecourt perimeter
- The service elevator to the concourse level and along with covered walkways have now been removed
- Works have begun on the landscaping between Cobbers Memorial and St Kilda Road

# WORKS UPDATE

## ALBERT ROAD RESERVE STATION ENTRANCE



- Formwork and concrete pour is now complete on the stairs leading from the station entrance down to Albert Reserve
- Paving is progressing from north to south at the station forecourt
- South African Soldiers Memorial scaffolding is at its final height and the reconstruction is expected to be complete next month
- Works will commence this month on the construction of the Albert Road South connection into St Kilda Road

## WORKS UPDATE

### CENTRE MEDIAN, CHILLER PLANTS AND STATION VENTILATION



- Low level planting is now complete in all sections of the St Kilda Road centre median
- Tree planting through the centre median will now commence (City of Melbourne)
- Chiller plant is now fully functional, operational noise testing is expected in late July 2024

## WORKS UPDATE

### DOMAIN ROAD AND EDMUND HERRING OVAL



EHO Site



- Construction of the new dual-purpose bus/tram stop has now commenced
- Demolition of the concrete hard stand on Edmund Herring Oval (EHO) is progressing
- The electrical substation is decommissioned and will be removed from site in the coming weeks

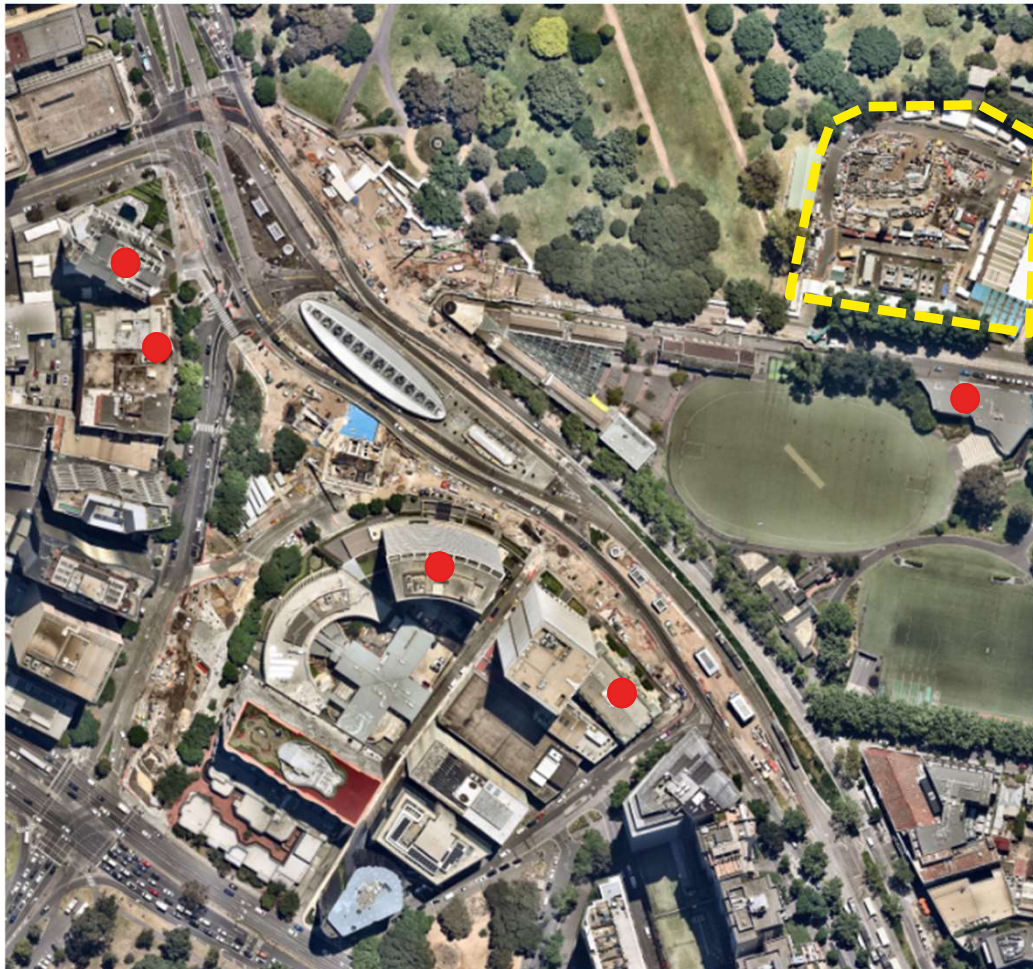
