About this event

Join the Metro Tunnel team on a walking tour of the new Anzac Station. This is an exciting opportunity to celebrate the completion of major construction at Anzac Station.

Anzac Station will give Victorians train access to Domain area's growing employment, education and residential precinct for the first time when the Metro Tunnel opens in 2025.

The station is on the doorstep of some of Melbourne's most important destinations, including the Shrine of Remembrance, Royal Botanic Gardens, the Alfred Hospital and Albert Park – and will take pressure off the busy Swanston Street tram corridor.

Terms and Conditions

- Participation is at the sole discretion of the event organisers
- The invitation is not to be forwarded to unintended recipients
- Event tickets are non-transferrable
- Participants must wear flat, fully enclosed shoes that lace or zip up, long pants and sleeves
- Participants are to present their event ticket upon arrival, prior to the tour commencing. All participants must have been issued an individual ticket
- Participants are to arrive 20 minutes prior to the allocated tour start time for registration and to complete an essential safety briefing
- The safety briefing will be held before tours commence and participants must agree to follow all instructions during the tour
- Tours will proceed in the event of rain, if safe to do so. Due to timing and capacity constraints, no guarantee can be given that interrupted tours will be rescheduled on the day of the event
- The project has strict safety and environmental management systems in place, however, as with any construction site, there is a range of inherent risks associated with access
- Tour numbers are limited and each tour will last approximately 40 minutes
- Smoking or the use of e-cigarettes is not permitted
- Photographs and video will be taken on the day by event staff. Images and footage taken may be used for post-event promotional purposes.

- Access to the site will be via Domain Road, near St Kilda Road
- Parking: No on-site parking is available
- Tram: Anzac Station Tram Stop #20 - Routes 3, 5, 6, 16, 58, 64, 67, 72, which is a 2-minute walk to the event entrance
- Cycling: Limited on-street bicycle parking is available
- Ride share services can be directed to the event site on Domain Road at Anzac Station.

Acknowledgement and agreement

I, the Visitor acknowledge and agree that:

- I visit the site solely at my own risk;
- At all times, I will exercise a high level of care for my personal safety during my visit to the Anzac Station site;
